Financial

In the bank: \$7137

\$4080 of this is from a grant to be used only for DVDs for backing up tapes BEBA's payroll taxes which include amounts deducted from employee's pay and those BEBA pays will be about \$6000 instead of \$3500 (an increase of \$2500).

We can possibly save in other areas.

Maria Krekeler, Executive Director for Pathwork California has volunteered to spend a weekend a month helping Sandra with organizing the BEBA tapes/administrative files, etc. Yeah! She came in March and is returning in a week.

The Parent/professional workshop at Waldorf 3/13 received lots of positive feedback from parents attending. It brought in \$1210. \$70 went to Waldorf and Ray was paid 1/2 of the balance.

Donations have been low this quarter and we have a lot of families paying minimal amounts. We have applied for only one grant for \$1000, through Wells Fargo at Dorothy Adler's suggestion.
